GETTING THERE

AIRPORT: HAM Hamburg Airport

To save the environment, time, and money, we will use public transportation. There will be two meeting points. The meeting point for bus/train travelers is at the central bus station across the street from the central train station (Hamburg Hauptbahnhof). The other meeting point is at the airport.

Please arrive at one of the meeting points at 4 PM sharp. We will leave at 4:05 PM. If you arrive early, enjoy your time in Hamburg and come to the train station meeting point at 4 PM. If you come by bike, car, or by walking, use a navigation app guide you to the CISV House.

For departure, we suggest those who are going to the airport leave at 1 PM sharp and the ones who will go to the train/bus stations leave at 1:30 PM. It will take you one hour to reach these destinations so please plan accordingly and allow time for security checks at the airport.

PARTICIPATION FEES

DOCUMENTS

Participants aged under 18 must bring a completed and signed [Travelling Without Adult Leader \(TWAL\) form](#). There are no age requirements for the trainings but please be aware that the Youth Protection Act in Germany restricts partying after midnight, drinking of alcohol, and smoking for persons younger than 18 years of age. Those rules will apply at the RTF.

Please [check whether you will need a visa to travel to Germany](#). Be aware that if you will need to apply for a Schengen Visa, the application process can take up to two months. If you need an invitation letter to obtain the Visa, please [contact us](#) as early as possible.
