

CISV PARTICIPATION IN ACTIONS AND DEMONSTRATIONS

As situations vary so much globally, CISV International cannot give explicit authorization to National Associations to use CISV's name / logo to support peace demonstrations.

Therefore, NAs themselves must set their own Rules consistent with the following guidelines:

- A) The proposed action must conform to all local / regional / national / international laws
- B) The proposed action must be consistent with the goals / philosophy / rules of CISV International and the national CISV Constitution
- C) The proposed action must respect the international and intercultural character of CISV and its independent non-political status.

CISV educates young people around the world towards peace and encourages its members to incorporate CISV's goals into their lives and act, as individuals, in a peaceful manner consistent with the CISV philosophy. Accordingly, CISV cannot forbid as members, as individuals, to participate in actions and demonstrations.
